USGA RULES GOVERN PLAY

- All penalty areas are defined by red lines or stakes.
- In the absence of red lines or stakes, the grass line at the water's edge shall determine the margin of the penalty area.
- Out of bounds is defined by roadways, white stakes or lines.
- Embedded ball rule is in effect through the green.
- Drop zone located on Holes #3, #14 and #16 on Whispering Oak. Hole #6 on Old Orange.
- Coquina Cart Paths greenside on Holes #5 and #8 of Old Orange are considered an obstruction; you are entitled to free relief no closer to the hole.

ETIQUETTE

- Please protect our greens and fairways.
- Obey 90° cart rule.
- Keep carts on cart paths around tees, greens and all par 3's.
- Repair ball marks immediately.
- Fill divots with sand and rake bunkers.

PACE OF PLAY

Pace of play is four hours.

LIGHTNING POLICY

If you see lightning or hear thunder, you are at risk and we advise you to take shelter. Verandah Club also has a lightning prediction system that will sound an alarm when unsafe conditions are present. A solid 15-second blast of the horns means the system is predicting lightning and you should seek shelter.

Once the system does not detect lightning in the surrounding area, a signal will be sent to the horns to activate. This signal is (3) five-second blasts. You can safely return to the golf course when you hear (3) five-second blasts.
